

BYLAW 16/2005

A Bylaw of the Town of Morinville in the Province of Alberta to Provide for the Appointment of an Assessor as a Designate Officer

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 210(1), Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26, statues of Alberta, 2000, as follows:

“A Council may by Bylaw establish one or more position to carry out the powers, duties and functions, of a designate officer under this or any other enactment or Bylaw”

AND WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 284(d)(ii), Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26, Statutes of Alberta 2000 defines as follows:

“assessor means a person appointed by a municipality to the position of designated officer to carry out the duties and responsibilities of an assessor under this act, and includes any person to whom those duties and responsibilities are delegate by the person referred to in subclause (i) or (ii)”;


NOW THEREFORE, the Town of Morinville Council duly assembled hereby enacts as follows:

1. Municipal Assessment Services Group Inc., be appointed as a designated officer to carry out the duties and responsibilities of municipal assessor as prescribed in the Municipal Government Act, as amended or repealed, and any other relevant statute or regulation or bylaw making reference to the assessor.
2. That this Bylaw shall take full force and effect upon third and final reading and upon signing in accordance with Section 213, Municipal Government Act, being Chapter M-26, Statues of Alberta, 2000.
