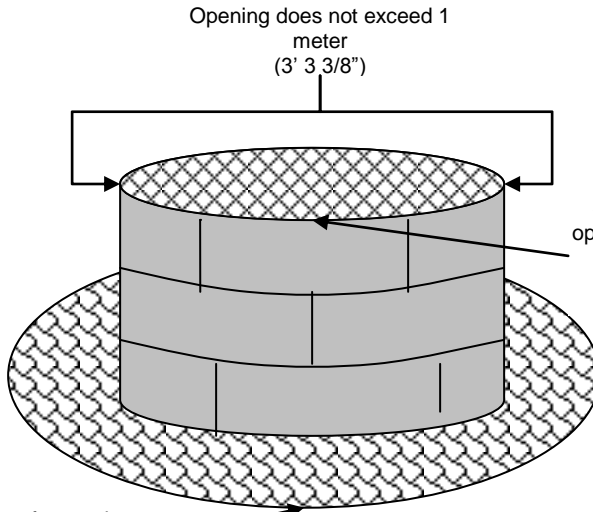


FIRE PIT GUIDELINE (for example only)

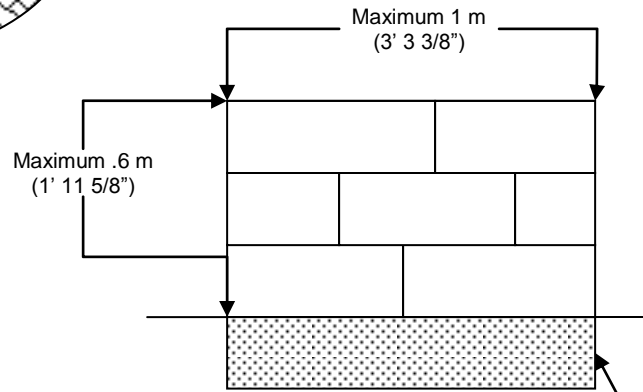
3 metres to any structures, property lines or combustible materials



Spark Arrestor Screen with opening no larger than 1.25 cm (1/2")
 Height not to exceed 0.6 m (1' 11 5/8")

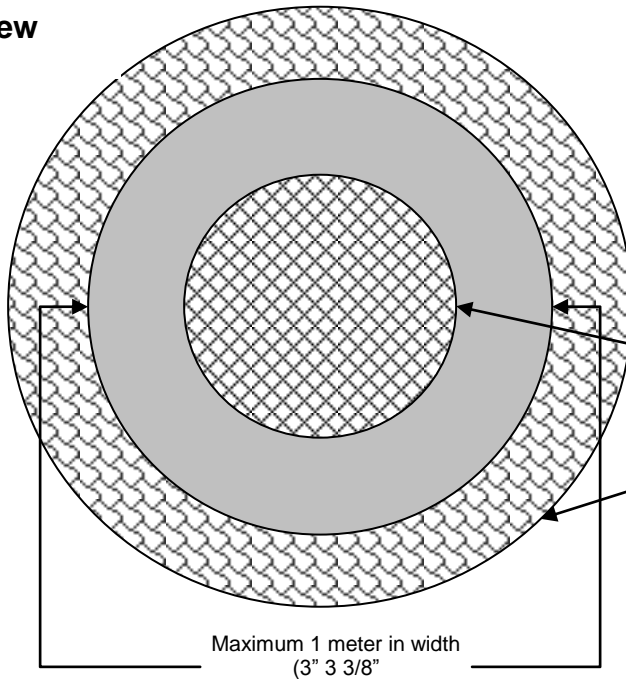
Side View

Suggested layer of poured concrete, bricks, sand, gravel or rocks around outside of pit



.1 m (4") sand (suggested)

Top View



Minimum 3 metres to any structures or property lines (9' 10")

Spark Arrestor Screen with openings no larger than 1.25 cm (1/2")

Suggested area of poured concrete, bricks, sand, gravel or stones

Maximum 1 meter in width (3' 3 3/8")

FIRE CONTROL BYLAW #2/96

Permits are required for any and all of the following:

Open Air Fires – Permitted in special situations only

Ground Thawing for Utility Lines

Acceptable Fire Pit – 5 year permit, site inspected by the Morinville Fire Department (includes new and existing fire pits)

Fireworks – Only allowed as organized neighbourhood display

All Permits	\$20.00
Extensions	\$10.00
Fines	\$50.00 - \$250.00

Permits are available at the Town of Morinville Office, 10125 – 100 Avenue, Monday to Friday 8:00 am to 4:30 pm.
