BYLAW 29/81

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF MORINVILLE TO
ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF
ST. ALBERT.

WHEREAS Section 155 of the Municipal Government Act provides the means whereby the Town of Morinville may enter into a Mutual Aid Fire Agreement with the City of St. Albert;

AND WHEREAS the City of St. Albert has submitted a draft copy of a proposed agreement to be entered into between the City of St. Albert and the Town of Morinville;

AND WHEREAS it is expedient for the Town of Morinville to enter into such an agreement;


NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MORINVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Mayor & Town Manager are hereby authorized to execute on behalf of the Town of Morinville a Mutual Aid Fire Agreement with the City of St. Albert, each party mutually agreeing to provide assistance to the other in the event of a fire or other disaster within the corporate boundaries of either the Town or the City.
2. The agreement shall be in the form and substance as attached to this Bylaw as Schedule A and made part thereof.

READ a second time this 27 day of October 1981.

READ a third time and finally passed this 27 day of October 1981.
