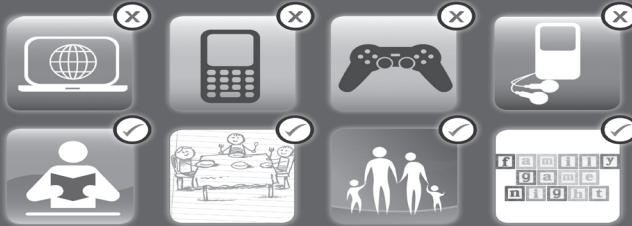
REMINDER! Business Licences are due to be renewed by Jan. 31! According to the

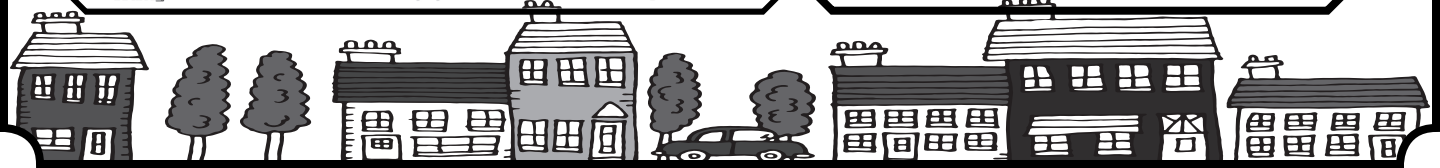

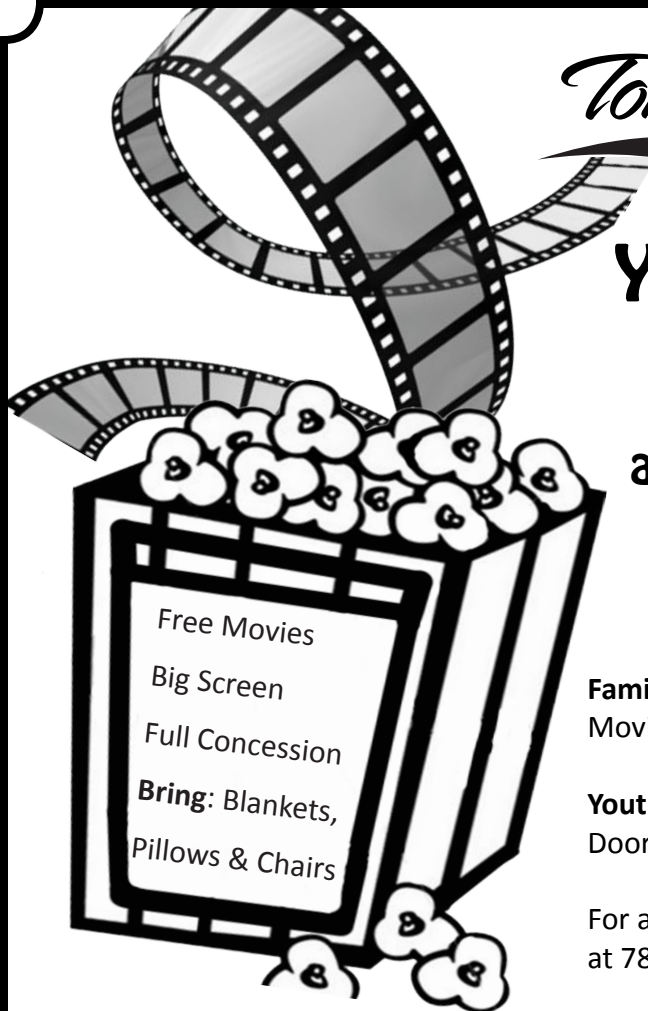
