

BYLAW 24/84

BEING A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF MORINVILLE IN THE PROVINCE
OF ALBERTA TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS
OF BYLAWS IN GENERAL.

WHEREAS, it is deemed desirable that a bylaw be enacted to
provide for a general penalty,

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Council may, pursuant to Section
110 of the Municipal Government Act being Chapter M-26 of
the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1980 and amendments thereto,
pass a bylaw to provide for a general penalty,

NOW THEREFORE, the Municipal Council of the Town of Morinville,
duly assembled, enacts as follows:

I. TITLE

This Bylaw may be cited as the "General Penalty
Bylaw".

II. DEFINITION

Town - means the Town of Morinville.


III GENERAL

Any person who contravenes any provision of a Town
Bylaw for the contravention of which no punishment
has been specifically provided is guilty of an offence
and liable to imprisonment for a term of not more
than 6 months, or to a fine of not more than \$2,500.00
or to both fine and imprisonment.

READ a third time and finally passed this 9th day of October
A.D. 1984.
