BYLAW 10/2010

A BYLAW OF THE TOWN OF MORINVILLE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA TO AUTHORIZE THE TOWN OF MORINVILLE TO IMPOSE A 2010 SUPPLEMENTARY ASSESSMENTS FOR IMPROVEMENTS

WHEREAS Section 369 of the Municipal Government Act, provides that the Council must pass a Supplementary Tax Bylaw to authorize it to impose a supplementary property tax in respect of property for which supplementary assessments have been prepared.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Town of Morinville in the Province of Alberta duly assembled, enacts:

1. CITATION

1.1 This Bylaw may be cited as the Town of Morinville Supplementary Tax Bylaw 2010.

2. DEFINITIONS

In this Bylaw:

2.1 "Council" shall mean the duly elected officers of the Town of Morinville and the Chief Elected Officer.

2.2 "Chief Administration Officer (CAO)" shall mean the Chief Administrative Officer of the Town of Morinville or the Director(s) or Department(s) designated by the Chief Administrative Officer.

2.3 "Morinville" shall mean the Municipality of Morinville in the Province of Alberta.

3. SUPPLEMENTARY TAX

3.1 Morinville is authorized to prepare supplementary assessments for all improvements, except linear property, for the purpose of imposing a tax under Part 10 of the *Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, c M-26*.

4. SEVERANCE

4.1 If any Section or Sections of this Bylaw or parts thereof are found in any court of law to be illegal or beyond the power of Council to enact, such Section or Sections or parts thereof shall be deemed to be severable and all other Sections or parts of this Bylaw shall be deemed to be separate and independent therefrom and to be enacted as such.


5. COMING INTO EFFECT

5.1 This Bylaw shall come into force and effect upon third reading the Bylaw.


READ a first time this 27th day of April, 2010.

READ a second time this 27th day of April, 2010.

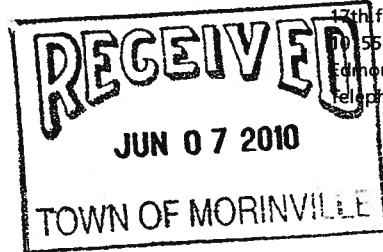
READ a third time and finally passed this 11th day of May, 2010.


