Volunteer Opportunities

L.I.T. Orientation Day/ Prep Day: June 30 from 10 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

This day is a **mandatory** event as it will prepare you for the L.I.T. role within the summer camp programs and you will assist summer staff with camp preparations. Lunch is provided. Following lunch you will have an opportunity to bond with the other L.I.T.'s and get to know all of the summer staff in a fun way.

***Theme Weekly Camps: July 6 – August 21 from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.**

L.I.T.'s pick one week (30 hour week) that they will volunteer

This is the opportunity for you to showcase your talents as a L.I.T. on your scheduled volunteer week. As the days become fill up with activities be prepared to help with set up/clean up, assisting staff with the crafts and activities and helping any children that may just need a friend.

***You must complete one full week during Weekly Theme Camps
to receive a certificate.**

L.I.T. Information

- Morinville Youth attending grades of 9 -11 can apply to be part of our L.I.T. team.
- In order to qualify for summer camp dates you **must** participate in the L.I.T. orientation/prep day.
- Hours of work: Monday to Friday of a summer camp week from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- The majority of activities will take place at the MCCC with activities around Morinville. When a field trip occurs on a L.I.T. volunteer date, the L.I.T.'s will be moved into the other summer camp room.
- L.I.T.'s helping with youth programs will be expected to interact with the children, assist camp counselors with crafts and the implementation of activities, as well as encouraging fun and participation for all campers.
- L.I.T.'s will have opportunities to plan and demonstrate their own games or activities.
- At the end of the summer program, each L.I.T. will be provided a certificate of volunteer hours if you have completed one full week of volunteering (30 hour week).
- Each L.I.T. will be provided with a shirt. Long shorts/pants and comfortable closed toe footwear is the responsibility of the L.I.T.
- Applications must be completed prior to deadline (with no exceptions) and approved by the Summer Programmers
- There is no fee to participate.
- We are looking for a maximum of 12 L.I.T.'s for the summer. One L.I.T. per group per week.
- You will be required to complete a criminal record check if you are chosen as one of the L.I.T.s following the interviews. The cost for this will be covered as we will give you a letter to bring in to the detachment.

NOTE: L.I.T.'s WILL NOT be expected to provide discipline or deal with any major issues that may occur, as these will be referred to a Camp Counselor.
