

## Volunteer Position Description: Event Security

Under the direction and guidance of the Lite Up the Nite Team Lead, event security volunteers will ensure a safe spectator experience for the annual Lite Up the Nite Fireworks show.

### Responsibilities will also include:

- Monitoring the event. You will make sure rules are followed and help provide a sense of safety for all event attendees, staff, and volunteers.
- Maintaining order. This may include directing traffic, pedestrians, assisting lost people, or providing support for disturbances.
- Escorting attendees to safety or out the event. This may include making sure people don't re-enter when they aren't supposed to or assisting someone with health problems to a safe area.
- Communication. Reporting concerns to event staff in a professional, timely fashion.
- Answering questions from spectators. (We'll provide answers to commonly asked questions.)

The position will involve approximately 2-3 hours on Saturday, November 26. Event security will have the opportunity to build meaningful work relationships with a broad range of individuals from business leaders to community-oriented residents, and others.

### Qualifications necessary for success in this position.

- Be firm, but friendly. You'll help control crowds and keep the site clear of obstacles.
- Be safety conscious. You will need to maintain a safe event site, preventing spectators from moving into discharge zone.
- Be available from check-in at 6:00 p.m. (or earlier) until 8:00 p.m. (or later) on Saturday, November 26, 2022.
- Be pleasant, helpful, and confident providing direction to others.
- Be willing to have fun. Most people who attend our events are awesome. So, your job is often not very difficult, meaning you'll have a great night.

### Additional Information

The night of the fireworks show, November 26, requires standing and/or walking for extended periods of time. We will provide you with a safety vest and/or radios the day of for visibility, safety, and to facilitate communication.

### Benefits

The position gives you the opportunity to give back to our community, meet new people, and gain valuable work experience. Volunteers may also receive a volunteer work confirmation letter and honorarium of \$25.
