

## Volunteer Position Description: Parade Marshal(s)

Under the direction and guidance of the Lite Up the Nite Parade Coordinator, parade marshals will ensure the effective pacing of the parade and support the safety of participants and spectators.

### Responsibilities will also include

- Providing support with parade staging (lining up (which entries go in which order);
- support the Parade Coordinator with parade logistics, including preparing and set up and take-down of signage and barricades;
- Assisting with the site preparations the evening of the event; directing participants during the event; and answering questions from spectators. (Don't worry, we'll help you with answers to commonly asked questions.)

The position will involve approximately 4-6 hours on Saturday, November 26. Parade Marshals will have the opportunity to build meaningful work relationships with a broad range of individuals from business leaders to community-oriented residents, and others.

### Qualifications necessary for success in this position.

- Be firm, but friendly. You'll help pace the parade flow and keep the route clear of obstacles.
- Be safety conscious. You will need to maintain the curb line, preventing spectators from moving into the street.
- Be available from check-in at 4:15 p.m. (or earlier) until 7:30 p.m. (or later) on Saturday, November 26, 2022.
- Be pleasant, helpful, and confident providing direction to others.
- Be willing to have fun. Most people who attend our parade are awesome. So, your job is often not very difficult, meaning you'll have a great night.

### Additional Information

Parade Day, November 26, requires standing and/or walking for extended periods of time. We will provide you with a safety vest the day of for visibility and safety.

### Benefits

The position gives you the opportunity to give back to our community, meet new people, and gain valuable work experience. Volunteers may also receive a volunteer work confirmation letter and honorarium of \$25.
