



Call for Non-Profit Snack Concessions

The Town of Morinville is inviting non-profit groups to apply to operate a snack concession at select community events. This opportunity allows organizations to raise funds while supporting a safe, family-friendly event. Concessions are typically run from the Morinville Community Cultural Centre Bar Service Area or Table Booth.

Eligibility

- Registered non-profit organization
- Funds raised must support community-based programs or initiatives
- One designated Concession Lead (18+) must be identified

Responsibilities

- Provide simple snack and beverage items
- Supply required equipment for service, and volunteers
- Manage all cash handling and payment systems
- Maintain cleanliness during the event and complete full clean-up
- Follow assigned set-up, operating, and tear-down times

Requirements

- One designated [Food Safety Certification](#) Lead (18+)
- Required Alberta Health Services (AHS) [Event Notification](#)
- General liability insurance naming the Town of Morinville as Additional Insured
- Menu and pricing submitted for approval in advance
- Compliance with all Town policies, event rules, and safety procedures

Important Information

- Alcohol sales are not permitted
- Concession spaces are limited and assigned by the Town
- Groups must operate for the full approved event hours

- Snack Concession Application
- Proof of food safety certification and insurance
