

PROCLAMATION

Heritage Day

August 3rd, 2026

WHEREAS: IN 1947 the Government of Alberta marks the first Monday of August as Heritage Day, meant to celebrate the cultural and historical heritage of the province; and

WHEREAS: Known for its sunshine, fresh air, and open spaces, Alberta is a melting pot of different cultures and ethnicities. The people of Alberta celebrate this diversity, each year, with Heritage Day, which is observed on the first Monday in August; and

WHEREAS: Canadians use the long weekend to go on out-of-town trips and to spend time with family and friends. Activities include camping trips, hiking tours or quiet retreats. Many families and tourists plan to visit museums such as Fort Calgary, which celebrates Alberta's Heritage Day with interpretive tours, movies, crafts, face paintings, a treasure hunt and genealogy presentations;
