

Subdivision and Development Appeal Board

Purpose:

A Subdivision and Development Appeal Board (SDAB) is a statutory body intended to perform an independent adjudicative function that hears complaints and functions in a manner similar to a court of law. It is an administrative board mandated by the Municipal Government Act (MGA) and created by a municipality to carry out appropriate functions and procedures. The SDAB hears appeals from municipal subdivision and development authorities.

Membership:

2 members of Council5 members from the Public at Large

Term:

Members of Council are appointed at the annual Organizational Meeting of Council for a 1-year term.

Members from the Public at Large are appointed for a 2-year term, and no such member may serve more than 3 consecutive terms.
