Utility Account Collection Policy

SECTION A

1.0 **Policy Purpose**

To establish a policy which authorizes Administration to collect on unpaid utility accounts and to close final accounts.

2.0 **Policy Statements**

Unpaid utility accounts are assessed a 2.5% penalty if not paid in full after 21 days as per the Water Rates, Sewer Rates, Waste Management and Stormwater Service Charges Bylaws.

- 2.1 The procedure to collect uncollectible utility accounts is as follows:
 - 30 Days Past due reminder letter sent to utility account holder indicating account is past due and to remit payment immediately to avoid further collection action.
 - 60 Days Second notice to pay letter sent to utility account holder indicating account will be sent collections or arrears balance will be transferred to tax roll
 - 2.1.3 90 Days Final notice to pay letter sent to utility account holder indicating account arrears will be transferred to owner's tax roll account.
 - 120 Days Utility, services are disconnected or the balance on the account will be transferred to the tax roll. Any utility deposit held is applied to the account.

2.2 **Final Bills**

Notice is provided in writing to all utility account holders with final bills. indicating any current and past due amounts along with any applicable penalties.

Final bill account holders are advised to remit payment due immediately to avoid further collection agency action.

3.0 Expiry Date

- 3.1 For the purposes of ensuring that this Policy is revised for ongoing relevancy and necessity, a review will occur prior to December 31, 2023. The policy shall be brought forth and repassed in its present or an amended form or rescinded.
- 3.2 This policy shall remain in effect if the review date passes prior to Council review.
